
## How it Works




Healthcare providers register for ECHO Programs at no cost. Providers join ECHO sessions via videoconferencing on a regularly scheduled basis









ECHO sessions include didactics from subject experts and cased based learning. Participants become part of a supportive community of practice connecting providers and an interprofessional team at an academic/hospital setting.



Participants are encouraged to present de-identified patient cases to the community, participate in discussions, and evaluation surveys. They also receive no cost CPD credits.





Overall, disparities in communities are reduced and health of populations increase as patients receive best practice care from their local healthcare providers.



Through the ECHO Model, community providers and specialists learn from each other, acquire knowledge, skills, increase competency and build a strong community of practice.
